A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A PLAN DEVELOPED FOR THE CITY BY THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS ARLINGTON, SCHOOL OF URBAN AND PUBLIC AFFAIRS; A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE CITY LIMITS AND FOR ALL EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTIONS, HEREIN REFERRED TO AS ETJ. NUMBER # 111011.

THAT: the Council hereby designates this Comprehensive Plan as the Official Comprehensive Plan for the City of Bruceville-Eddy, Texas, and


THAT: the City Council extends his hand in thankfulness and appreciation to the students of the School of Urban and Public Affairs, U.T.A, and

THAT: the City Council Thanks above all Doctor Barbara Becker, Dean and Professor at the School; who took the challenge of the city's request of a Comprehensive Plan to the students and helped develop the curriculum to allow for the Plan to be written, and

THAT: that the meeting at which this Resolution to adopt the Comprehensive Plan for the City of Bruceville-Eddy was open to the public, and that public notice of the meeting place, time and date was given as required by TLGC Chapter 551 which governs the Open Meetings Act.


