16-102 ACTIONS OF THE COUNCIL

- 1. In exercising its powers, the City Council may, reverse or affirm, wholly or partly, may modify the order, requirement, decision or determination appealed from and make such order, requirement, decision or determination as ought to be made and shall have all the powers of the officer from whom the appeal is taken including the power to impose reasonable conditions to be complied with by the applicant.
- 2. The concurring vote of four (4) members of the City Council shall be necessary to revise any order, requirement, decision or determination of any such administrative official, or to decide in favor of the applicant on any matter upon which it is required to pass under this Ordinance or to affect any variance in said Ordinance.
- 3. Any person or persons, jointly or severally, aggrieved by any decision of the City Council or any taxpayer or any officer, department or board of the City of Bruceville-Eddy may present to an appropriate court a petition, duly verified, setting forth that such decision is illegal, in whole or in part, specifying the grounds of illegality. Such petition shall be presented to the court within the (10) days after the filing of the decision by the City Council in the City offices and not thereafter.

16-103 FEE FOR PROCESSING CITY COUNCIL REQUESTS

The City Council may, by resolution, establish a processing fee to cover City Council case file preparation, maps, and postage for property owner notification, and other associated administrative expenses.

SECTION 19

AMENDMENTS

19-100 Any person or corporation having proprietary interest in any property affected by this Ordinance may petition the City Council for a change or amendment to the provisions of this Ordinance, or the City Council may, on its own motion, institute study and proposal for changes and amendments in the public interest.

19-101 PROCEDURE

- 1. The City Council may from time to time amend, supplement or change by ordinance the boundaries of the districts or the regulations herein established as provided by the statutes of the State of Texas.
- 2. Before taking action on any proposed amendment, supplement or change the City Council shall hold a public hearing on any application for any amendment or change. When any such amendment or change relates to a change in classification or boundary of a zoning district, written notice of public hearing before the City Council on the proposed amendment or change shall be sent to all owners of real property lying within two hundred (200') feet of the property on which the change is requested. Such notice shall be given not less than ten (10) days before the date set for hearing by posting such notice, properly addressed and postage paid, to each taxpayer as the ownership appears on the most recently approved tax roll. The City Council may not adopt a proposed change relating to a change in classification or boundary until after the thirtieth (30th) day after the date the notice outlined in this subsection 19-101(2) is given.
- 3. When any such amendment relates to a change of a zoning regulation or to the text of this Ordinance not affecting specific property, notice of the public hearing of the City Council shall be given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the City without the necessity of notifying property owners by mail. Notice of such hearing shall be given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the City stating the time and place of such hearing, which time shall not be earlier than fifteen (15) days from the date of publication.
 - 6. If a protest against such proposed amendment, supplement or change has been filed, duly signed and acknowledged by the owners of twenty percent (20%) or more, either of the area of the lots or land included in such a proposed change or those immediately adjoining the area extending two hundred feet (200') therefrom, such amendment shall not become effective except by a three-fourths vote of all members of the City Council.



WORKSHOP OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY REGULAR MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY

Workshop Session of the City of Bruceville-Eddy 5:00 p.m.

Council members present were: Connally Bass, Hal Wilcox, Allen Trigg, and Jason Dean. Also present, City Administrator Koni Billings, Chief Bill McLean, and City Engineer Johnny Tabor.

Agenda items were discussed, no action taken. Update given by Mr. Tabor on all the ongoing projects we have for the water department. The grant administrator and the grant engineer RFQ's have been scored and at the regular session of the council the line item states that a resolution that supports the hiring of the two candidates that scored highest will be asked to be supported. The map that is necessary to be updated was delivered and Mr. Tabor has asked that it be returned to his office as quickly as possible for it will be necessary that he have the updates scored into the GIS program to be able to publish the entirety of the water system, its lines and sizes, and the meter placements. This is to update the many meter vacates that were done this past year, in order to be in complete compliance with TCEQ and their regulations which governs the amount of water per meter is allowed. There was some discussion on the legal jargon that will be necessary to open the public meeting on the rezoning application for Ms. Williams regarding her two lots that she owns, which is to be decided on in this evening's regular session. Chief McLean introduced the two new police officers, Louise Lopez and William Rivas. The two new officers have reserved for us in the past.

Meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.

Public Hearing: Hearing opened at 6:05 p.m. The application for re-zoning two lots of Ms. Vivian Williams was read. The two lots are located at 301, 303 West Third in Eddy, Texas and are currently zoned SF-3. Request is to have them rezoned to GBD.

Item 2: Police Report: Councilman Hal Wilcox has announced that Officers Louise Lopez and William Rivas have been hired to replace Officers Bell and Sanchez. Both have been reserve officers for the city in the past. No motion necessary.

Item 3: Public Works. Mr. Wilcox has asked if there is any interest in requesting another meeting from TXDOT and Primus to update us on the construction on both projects of the highway expansion. Mrs. Billings was asked to contact TXDOT and make the request for either a workshop of public meeting to give the council an update on any new deadlines or completed projects. Council will adjourn in executive session at the end of the agenda for an update from city water attorney.

Item 4: Council discussed the request for rezoning two parcel lots owned by citizen Vivian Williams located at 301, 303 West Third Street. The lots are currently zoned SF# and the request is to be rezoned to G.B.D. A motion from Connally Bass, which was seconded by Allen Trigg, passed that rezone request. All in Favor.

A motion was made by Connally Bass and was seconded by Jason Dean to appoint both of the firms to handle the professional services for the CDBG 2016 grant. All in Favor.

Item 6: Council considered the passage of Ordinance #10-2016-01, which adopts and enacts a new Code of Ordinances. This is to enact immediately, with no severability, all other existing ordinances of the City of Bruceville-Eddy, which the legal firm of Franklin Legal Publishing has codified. This brings into law the entire reviewed city ordinance, which upon passage is deemed, incorporated into the Code. A motion to accept and pass this Ordinance, which incorporates all ordinances, was motioned by Jason Dean. A seconded followed, tendered by Allen Trigg. All in Favor.

Item 7: Proposed wage reviews have been tabled until November agenda. Council asked that Gary Lucas be in attendance and that the reviews be sent to them in order to look at all requested wage increases. No motion necessary.

Regular Session adjourned into executive session at 7:00 pm. Discussion of update from City water company attorney, agenda item 2. Council reconvened into regular session at 7:15 pm.

Mr. Wilcox noted to the audience that a letter commending David Ash, the new ACO officer had been received and he read it to the audience before council adjourned.

Mr. Trigg made a motion to adjourn at 7:16 pm.

ENGINEER'S REPORT ON PROJECTS - 9/8/16 (updated 10-13-16)

(See past Engineer's Reports for historical updates.)

State Highway 7 / Boyd Williams Water Line:

9-8-16 Update: TxDOT Permits have been issued and we are waiting on Breton Backhoe Service to provide an amended cost for the new pipeline route.

10-13-16 Update: Construction contract for this project was issued to Breton Backhoe Service in the amount of \$22,667.50 with a start date of 10-17-16 and a completion date of 12-1-16.

USDA-RD New Sewer System:

The project is waiting on income survey results and response from agencies about environmental issues and impact. Collection system is 70% designed but requires environmental letters from all agencies to continue. Every City street was identified to have a sewer line installed to avoid future environmental clearance issues if routes had to be changed. Sewage treatment alternatives are 50% complete, but requires environmental letters from all agencies to continue. Response letters have been received from 5 of 15 agencies. The agencies will get two requests and we must wait until early October to proceed without a response. The Texas Historical Commission has responded and will require an archeologist investigation and report (see attached THC letter). I will contact Archeologists to get proposals.

9-8-16 Update: Preliminary Engineering Report and Environmental Report were delivered to USDA RD Hillsboro Office today. The estimated total project cost in the report is \$10,180,420.

10-13-16 Update: USDA RD review of Environmental Report has not been received. Review of the Preliminary Engineering Report was received from USDA RD on September 28th. I anticipate all of their comments to be addressed by the end of this month.

Water System Mapping & Hydraulic Analysis:

We are waiting on marked-up maps from city staff showing correct location of lines, valves and meters.

9-8-16 Update: No Change

10-13-16 Update: No Change (waiting on second mark-up maps by Bruceville-Eddy delivered

7-14-16).

Water Loss:

City staff is repairing and looking for leaks. Water main metering for leak detection can resume when summer flows go down. Water main meters can then be installed to measure low flow (night time) conditions to identify the direction/location of high flows from large leaks or other usage.

9-8-16 Update: No Change

10-13-16 Update: No Change (City Staff is searching for and repairing leaks and monitoring RVS Billing Water Loss Reports.

Old Blevins Rd New 4" Water Line:

This project is ready to be approved by the Council for bidding. All but 2 of the updated (new) easements have been secured. The new 4" water main will be placed in the existing water line easement where new easements are not granted.

9-8-16 Update: No Change

10-13-16 Update: No Change (This project is awaiting authorization by the Council under the 2017 Budget).

TxCDBG - TDA Contract #7216061 - Water Improvements:

This project is to install a new 10" distribution main from the Ford Elevated Tank and connect to Melissa Street, Temple Street, and 4th Street. The project also includes a new 6" water main to connect from the 6" pressure reducing valve near Mackey Ranch Road to Horseshoe Bend.

9-8-16 Update: The City is in the processing of selecting a Grant Administrator and an Engineer as required by the rules of the program.

10-13-16 Update: Selection of the Professional Service Providers is on the Agenda for today's Council Meeting.

Friendly Oaks Tank Repair:

Existing ground tanks require repair and painting to comply with TCEQ. Council should authorize the Engineer to prepare bid documents, advertise and get bids for the work. Engineer will present bids to Council for review and action.

9-8-16 Update: No Change

10-13-16 Update: These tanks need repair and painting and will likely be a Notice of Violation at the next TCEQ Inspection.

TxDOT I35 Water Line Relocation:

This project is 90% complete. We are waiting on TxDOT's water line contractors to remobilize to remove the old water lines and identify any old lines that they must cut and capped.

12-10-15 Update: TxDOT/TTG Utilities Inc. contractor has completed water line connections near FM 1239 and also near Grider Street. The last part of the TxDOT work will be removing the old lines which may <u>result in leaks if the old lines are still connected to the system</u> at unknown locations.

9-8-16 Update: All of the final documents have been submitted to TxDOT for the final completion and reimbursement from TxDOT.

10-13-16 Update: No Change

Old Bethany Road Bridge Replacement (Crescent Creek 6" Water Line):

McLennan County will replace the bridge at Old Bethany Road and South Fork Cow Bayou. The City's existing 8" water line which was placed on the bridge must be removed within the next 2 to 3 months. The Council needs to schedule a Called Meeting to discuss the best plan and budget for relocating the existing 8" water line.

9-8-16 Update: The County has scheduled bids to be received for the bridge reconstruction in December 2016 and construction is scheduled to start in February 2017. The Crescent Creek 6" line must be installed and the 8" water line on the bridge must be removed before bids for bridge reconstruction are received by the County. The City is trying to get a route for the Crescent Creek line to follow an existing 1-1/2" main or get a new easement from the landowner.

10-13-16 Update: This project is waiting on the City to obtain water line easements from the IH 35 right-of-way to the 6" line on Crescent Creek Road.

Ranchcrest to Old Bethany Pump Station Improvements:

New 8" Water Line from Pump Station to Agnes Wills Road.

10-13-16 Update: Barlow Tank Inc. has located the 6" line from Agnes Wills Road to Ranchcrest. They will not be able to construct the short line from Westward Trail to Agnes Wills Road due to their workload. The 8" water line along Old Bethany Road will require identification of necessary easements. Easements will include prescription type easements, existing easements, and new easements. I will provide water line route sheets to aid the City to in obtaining and identifying easements.

Dear Landowner.

I am writing on behalf of the Waco-McLennan County Emergency Management Office. According to the McLennan County Appraisal District you own property in the Cow Bayou Watershed. We have been working for several years to complete Emergency Action Plans (EAPs) in the event of a breach of one or more of the dams on the watershed structures (lakes and dams). If that occurs, there are safety concerns about the volume of water traveling through the flood plain and the possibility of loss of life and/or property.

I have been working with the State of Texas Commission for Environmental Quality, McLennan County Engineering Office, the Natural Resource Conservation Service and the McLennan County Office of Emergency Management to identify landowners and obtain contact information so that if a dam breach occurs you may be quickly notified, either to evacuate or make plans for livestock, structures, or equipment in the floodplain.

The McLennan County Tax Office does not retain telephone numbers, many people now use only cell phones, and there may be structures or houses in areas that have not been physically identified. So that we can alert you in the event of an impending emergency we need some contact information.

The Office of Emergency Management has provided a website for registration if you wish to be contacted in the event of a watershed emergency. Though not mandatory, it is highly recommended for your safety and the safety of your property. The information will not be shared outside the emergency management structure and there is no charge to you.
