ORDINANCE 4-11-2024-1 AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CITY OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY, TEXAS CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION, SERIES 2024

STATE OF TEXAS §

CITY OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY §

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bruceville-Eddy, Texas (the "City"), deems it advisable to issue Certificates of Obligation of the City in accordance with the notice hereinafter set forth; therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY, TEXAS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found and declared to be true and correct.

Section 2. The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to cause to be published in the manner required by law and in substantially the form set forth on Exhibit "A" (which is expressly made a part hereof), a Notice of Intention to Issue Certificates of Obligation.

Section 3. The notice set forth in Section 2 above shall be published in English once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper which is of general circulation in the City, the date of the first publication to be not less than forty five (45) days prior to the date set in said notice for the passage of the Ordinance authorizing the issuance of such Certificates of Obligation.

Such notice shall also be posted continuously on the City website for at least 45 days (and continuously) until June 6, 2024.

<u>Section 4.</u> The Mayor, City Secretary, and other officers of the City Council are hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary or desirable to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

Section 6. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed is open to the public as required by law and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Bruceville-Eddy, Texas (the "City"), will meet in the Bruceville-Eddy City Hall, 144 Wilcox Drive, Eddy, TX 76524 at 6:00 p.m. on the 6th day of June, 2024, to adopt an Ordinance and take such other action as may be deemed necessary to authorize the issuance of the City of Bruceville-Eddy, Texas Certificates of Obligation, in one or more series, payable from City ad valorem taxes and net revenues of the waterworks and sewer system of the City, in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$15,861,000, bearing interest at any rate or rates, not to exceed the maximum interest rate now or hereafter authorized by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, and maturing over a period of years not to exceed forty (40) years from the date thereof, for the purpose of evidencing the indebtedness of the City for all or any part of the cost of construction of a new wastewater treatment and sewerage system to also include customer service facilities, land acquisition, rights-of-way, permits, professional services, and all appurtenances in connection therewith; and the cost of professional services incurred in connection therewith.

The public is further hereby notified as follows:

- (a) As of the date of this notice the current principal balance of all outstanding debt obligations of the City is \$1,635,326.
- (b) As of the date of this notice the combined principal and interest required to pay all outstanding debt obligations of the City on time and in full (which is based on the City's expectations related to the interest due on any variable rate debt of the City) is \$1,848,162.35.

- (c) The maximum principal amount of Certificates of Obligation to be issued is \$15,861,000.
- (d) The estimated combined principal and interest required to pay the Certificates of Obligation to be authorized on time and in full is \$26,168,959.37.
- (e) The estimated maximum interest rate for the Certificates of Obligation to be issued is 2.75% per annum. Such interest rate may vary based on market conditions but will not exceed the maximum legal interest rate.
- (f) The maximum maturity date of the Certificates of Obligation to be authorized is 40 years from the date the Certificates of Obligation are issued.

CODE OF ORDINANCES

GENERAL AMENDMENT

INCREASING CITY ADMINISTRATORS SPENDING LIMIT

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES AT ARTICLE 1.04 (OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES), DIVISION 2 (CITY ADMINISTRATOR), SECTION 1.04.034 (POWERS AND DUTIES), ITEM (9) BY INCREASING THE LIMIT FOR THE PURCHASE OF MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS OF FACT, APPROVAL, ENACTMENT, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, the City of Bruceville-Eddy ("City") is a general-law municipality of the State of Texas; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bruceville-Eddy ("City Council"), as the governing body of a municipality, is authorized by Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001 to adopt, amend, or repeal an ordinance, rule, or police regulation that is for the good government, peace, or order of the municipality or for the trade and commerce of the City, and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted to it by law; and
- **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.012 the City, as a Type A general-law municipality, has general authority to adopt an ordinance not inconsistent with state law, that is necessary for the government, interest, welfare, or good order of the municipality; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Bruceville-Eddy ("City Council"), finds is necessary to increase the City Administrator's spending limit in light of inflationary price increases for materials and supplies,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY, TEXAS:

SECTION I. FINDINGS OF FACT

THAT the findings set out in the preamble of this ordinance are true and correct.

SECTION II. APPROVAL

THAT City of Bruceville-Eddy, Texas deems it necessary to update and amend our ordinances to provide greater operational flexibility to the City Administrator to supervise the purchase of all materials, supplies and equipment for which funds are provided in the budget.

SECTION II. ENACTMENT

Article 1.04 (Officers and Employees), Division 2 (City Administrator), Section 1.04.034 (Powers and Duties), Item (9) shall read in accordance with <u>Attachment "A"</u> attached hereto and incorporated into this Ordinance for all intents and purposes. Any underlined text on <u>Attachment "A"</u> shall be inserted into the Code and any struck-through text shall be deleted from the Code.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY

THAT it is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that if any of the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of the Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the valid judgment of decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation of this Ordinance of unconstitutional or invalid phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and any publication as may be required by governing law.

Attachment "A"

- § 1.04.034 Powers and duties.
- (9) Supervise the purchase of all materials, supplies and equipment for which funds are provided in the budget; purchase materials and supplies necessary for operation or maintenance of city services for amounts up to and including two three thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) (\$3,000.00) and up to and including four thousand nine hundred ninety-nine and 99/100 dollars (\$4,999.99) with the proper approval of the governing body to the extent funds have been provided in the budget. No purchase shall be made, contract let or obligation incurred which exceeds the current budget appropriation without a supplemental appropriation by the governing body. No contract shall be let except by the mayor and the city council. The city administrator may issue such rules governing procedures for purchasing within the administrative organization as the governing body shall approve.
